Arable & combinable crops



● THE CHALLENGE

- Wet autumns keep sprayers and ATVs off the land
- Compaction and wheelings reduce yield
- Blackgrass and slug pressure on tight, weather-driven timings
- Establishment windows that cannot wait

WHAT WE DO

- Slug pellet application in unworkable conditions
- Cover and catch crops into standing crops
- Granular fertiliser, evenly applied
- Foliar feeds and biostimulants
- Crop mapping to target application

Horticulture & glasshouse



● THE CHALLENGE

- Shading must be applied each spring and removed each autumn
- Algae and grime on covers reduce vital light transmission
- Manual coating and cleaning is slow and works at height
- High-value crops, limited labour, short windows

WHAT WE DO

- Drone-applied shading coatings — ReduSystems
- Season-end coating removal and glass cleaning
- Polytunnel and glass algae removal
- Biocontrol and biostimulant application
- Crop health mapping (NDVI)

Solar farms



● THE CHALLENGE

- Soiling reduces output — dust, pollen, droppings and field drift
- Manual cleaning is slow, costly and risky on large arrays
- Access among live panels is awkward and hazardous
- Thousands of acres now consented across Lincolnshire & Cambridgeshire

WHAT WE DO

- Aerial panel washing — spray-cleaned from above
- Rapid coverage, with no contact on the glass
- Reaches awkward rows and tight gaps
- Deionised water — no streaking, no harsh chemicals
- Site mapping and condition surveys

Clean glass, more power.

Woodland & forestry



● THE CHALLENGE

- National tree-planting targets are accelerating
- Lincolnshire is the least-wooded county in the East Midlands
- Forestry England is creating 965+ hectares locally
- Wet, awkward or steep planting ground

WHAT WE DO

- Aerial direct seeding for woodland creation
- Natural regeneration and restock seeding
- Establishment and canopy mapping
- Rewilding and peatland seeding
- Vegetation control as approvals expand

Livestock & buildings



● THE CHALLENGE

- Summer heat stress reduces poultry and livestock performance
- Steel and fibre-cement roofs exceed 70°C in summer
- Hot buildings mean poor conditions and high cooling costs
- Roof work is a leading cause of fatal accidents in agriculture

WHAT WE DO

- Aerial-applied roof-cooling coating (Cool-FX)
- Roof up to 40°C cooler; interior 2–7°C lower
- Poultry, cattle, dairy and grain-store roofs
- No access onto fragile roofs — applied from above
- Re-applied each summer — an annual requirement

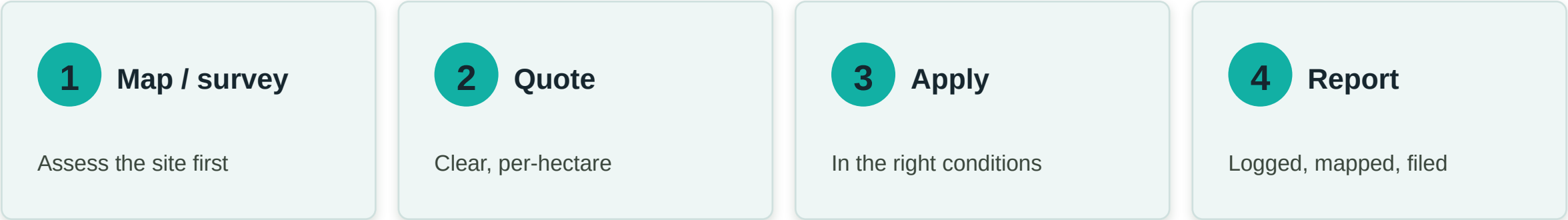
